RENEW YOUR RESPONSIBLE USE AGREEMENT (RUP) 2020-2021

Vancouver Public Schools (VPS) will issue students a one-to-one (1:1) technology device to promote achievement and provide flexible learning opportunities. This agreement outlines VPS expectations for students and families issued a device.

VPS requires a student's **parent or guardian** to review and agree to our responsible use and safety policy *each school year*. Students must also follow the VPS Technology Use Guidelines listed in the Student Code of Conduct.

Please use **Skyward Family Access** to complete one agreement for each of your students enrolled at VPS. This is **required** of every family. School personnel may contact you if the agreement is not complete within 15 days of the start of the school year.

If you have *never activated* your Skyward Family Access account, please click the link below to reset your password. Your email must match the one on record for your student. You will receive a second email with your account information and a link to access the Skyward login page.

Please do not share your Skyward Family Access login with your student. Students receive their own account.

Beginning Sept. 1, 2020, grab-and-go meals will be offered Monday through Friday from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the following locations:

Staff will request pin numbers (viewable in <u>Skyward Family Access</u> as "key pad number"). <u>See meal prices</u> or apply for free or reduced-price meals. <u>Get the form</u>. Families must reapply every year. Students who qualify for free meals will not be charged for grab-and-go meals. Need to add money to a student meal account? <u>Get directions.</u>

Whether you are renewing an application or applying for the first time, we encourage you to fill out a Free & Reduced Meal Application. A new application must be completed each school year.

NOTES FROM THE NURSE

We recognize that this is a difficult time to think about obtaining vaccinations for your child, but we want to urge you to keep on top of your child's required immunization schedule. Please contact your child's health care provider to ask if your child should be seen for their regular well child exams and immunizations. If you have concerns about safety, you may call ahead to inquire about any safety measures in place to keep your family safe and healthy while in the clinic.

The immunization law in Washington State changed, <u>beginning August 1, 2020</u>, students will not be allowed to attend school if they are out of compliance with vaccinations; <u>the 30 day</u> <u>grace period has been removed</u>.

Students will need to have up to date vaccinations in order to attend school beginning September 1, 2020 even in our Remote 2.0 environment.

PARENT KNOW-HOW: GET TEXT MESSAGE UPDATES

- 1. <u>Sign into your Skyward account.</u> If you cannot access your account, please call your child's school's office.
- 2. Visit the "Student info" tab (on a mobile device, click on the "+" to display menu). In the upper right corner, click "Request Changes for student," then select "Family information" from the dropdown.
- 3. In the pop-up window, select "Cell" and enter a valid cellphone number for each guardian. Click the "Save" button.

Please note that it may take up to 24 hours to begin receiving text messages.

If T-Mobile is your cell carrier, you must also opt in to receive text messages. This can be accomplished by doing one of the following:
